FURTHER ORDERED and **ADJUDGED** that petitioner's convictions for providing material support for terrorism and solicitation of others to commit war crimes be vacated and, after consideration of petitioner's alternative challenges to the conspiracy conviction, the case be remanded to the Court of Military Commission Review to determine the effect, if any, of the vacaturs on sentencing.
