Dear Ms. Miller:

As a vice president for marketing at the Trump Organization, you are likely intimately familiar with President Donald Trump and the inner workings of the Trump Organization. For example, you have made public statements on behalf of the Trump Organization regarding the Trump Organization's efforts to build a Trump Tower in Moscow.¹ In addition, the Committee has reason to believe that you may have information on other Trump business ties to Russia. Given your role in the Trump Organization, we believe that you have information that would assist the Committee in its investigation related to Russian interference in the 2016 presidential election. Accordingly, we are writing to request documents and schedule an interview with you in February 2018.

The Intelligence Community has concluded that Russia interfered in the 2016 election, with the goal of undermining faith in our democratic processes and harming Secretary Clinton's candidacy.² As explained in the January 6, 2017 Intelligence Community assessment: "We further assess Putin and the Russian Government developed a clear preference for President-elect Trump."³

The Committee is investigating these matters, and we ask that you provide the following documents in advance of your interview with the Committee, covering the time period from June 15, 2015, to the present:

1. All documents related to the June 9, 2016 meeting at Trump Tower among Donald Trump, Jr., Paul Manafort, Jared Kushner, Natalia Veselnitskaya, and others or any other meeting, or effort to arrange a meeting with any Trump campaign officials or family members, including all documents provided during the meeting and all documents relating to scheduling, what happened during the meeting(s), and any related actions taken after the meeting(s), including any statements made about the meeting(s);
2. All communications to, from, or copied to you with Aras Agalarov, Emin Agalarov, Irakly "Ike" Kaveladze, Roman Beniaminov, Rob Goldstone, Felix Sater, Igor Sechin, Herman Khan, or Sergey Gorkov;
3. All communications to, from, or copied to you concerning Russia, Ukraine, U.S. sanctions, or Vladimir Putin;
4. All communications concerning contacts between (a) you, Donald Trump, members of the Trump campaign or transition team, or associates of the Trump Organization, and (b) Russian government officials, associates, or representatives, including any individuals who purported to act or whom were believed to be acting on behalf of or in concert with Russian government officials, associates, or representatives, including any representative of Russian state-owned banks (e.g., Sberbank, Vnesheconombank, VEB, Vneshtorgbank, VTB) concerning Donald Trump or the 2016 U.S. election;
5. All communications concerning Russian interference in the 2016 election, including all communications regarding emails of the Democratic National Committee, John Podesta, or Hillary Clinton;
6. All documents concerning efforts by the Trump Organization or its affiliates to develop, or partner with a developer to build, a Trump-branded property in Moscow, Russia;
7. All communications to, from, or copied to you with WikiLeaks, DC Leaks, Guccifer 2.0, or their representatives;
8. All documents concerning Felix Sater or Bayrock Group LLC; and

9. All documents concerning efforts by the Trump Organization or its affiliates to develop, or partner with a developer to build, a Trump-branded property in Moscow, Russia.

We appreciate your cooperation and prompt attention to this important matter and ask that you provide the requested material as soon as possible, but no later than February 7, 2018. Please contact Brian Privor on my staff at (202) 224-7703 to schedule your interview and discuss arrangements for document production.
