Dear Mr. Leopold:

This is the final response to your January 11, 2021, Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request to the U.S. Department of Homeland Security (DHS). You are seeking:

- 1. All records, such as emails, text messages, memos, letters, directives, threat assessments, suspicious activity reporting, intelligence reports and intelligence bulletins and assessments and intelligence products, social media postings, collected by DHS and its component personnel, legal opinions, legal guidance, legal memos mentioning or referring to the planning of protests in Washington, DC on January 6, 2021, by supporters of President Donald Trump referred to as SAVE AMERICA RALLY and STOP THE STEAL and MARCH FOR TRUMP and First Amendment demonstrations and OPERATION FIRST AMENDMENT. Please be sure this search includes any correspondence sent and received by fusion centers, data centers and joint terrorism task forces; FBI, the White House, Office of the President and Vice President and the Executive Office of the President; Department of Justice, US Marshals Service, Washington, DC Mayor's Office and Metropolitan Police Department, the National Park Service and Department of Interior; Department of Defense and National Guard Bureau in DC; any individual Senator and Congressman/Congresswoman and any House and Senate committee; the US Capitol Police. The timeframe for this part of my request is December 1, 2020, through the date the search for responsive records is located.
- 2. All records, such as emails, text messages, memos, letters, reports, after action reports, intelligence assessments and bulletins, intelligence memoranda, social media postings, mentioning or referring to the insurrection, the siege, STORM THE CAPITOL, that took place at the Capitol building in Washington, DC on January 6, 2021. The timeframe for this part of my request is January 6, 2021, through the date the search for responsive records is conducted.
- 3. Photographs and audio and video of these January 6, 2021, protests and the siege/insurrection that took place at the Capitol building.

- 4. All records, as described in part 1, mentioning or referring to Million MAGA March.
- 5. All records mentioning or referring to tweets by Donald Trump that contain the words PROTESTS, RALLY, RALLIES ELECTION FRAUD, FRAUD, JANUARY SIXTH.
- 6. A copy of each assessment, report, and product provided to DHS from the National Capital Region Threat Intelligence Consortium, a DHS-recognized fusion center, between December 20, 2020, through the date the search for responsive records is conducted.

Your request was referred to DHS's Federal Protective Service (FPS) for processing and direct response to you. FPS received your request on January 21, 2021.

To provide you with the greatest degree of access authorized by law, DHS has considered your request under both the FOIA, 5 U.S.C. § 552, and the Privacy Act, 5 U.S.C. § 552a. In this case, a search of FPS for documents responsive to your request produced a total of 95 pages. Two pages originated with United States Capitol Police, and three pages originated with the District of Columbia Homeland Security and Emergency Management Agency's National Capital Region Threat Intelligence Consortium and are referred to those agencies for review and direct response to you.

Following review, DHS has determined that four pages are released in full, nine pages are completely withheld in their entirety, and 81 pages are partially releasable pursuant to 5 U.S.C. § 552 (b)(5), (b)(6), (b)(7)(A), (b)(7)(C), (b)(7)(E), and (b)(7)(F), FOIA Exemptions 5, 6, 7A, 7C, 7E, and 7F.

Enclosed are 81 pages with certain information withheld as described below:

FOIA Exemption 5 protects from disclosure those inter- or intra-agency documents that are normally privileged in the civil discovery context. The three most frequently invoked privileges are the deliberative process privilege, the attorney work-product privilege, and the attorney-client privilege. After carefully reviewing the responsive documents, I have determined that portions of the responsive documents qualify for protection under the

• Deliberative Process Privilege

The deliberative process privilege protects the integrity of the deliberative or decision-making processes within the agency by exempting from mandatory disclosure opinions, conclusions, and recommendations included within inter-agency or intra-agency memoranda or letters. The release of this internal information would discourage the expression of candid opinions and inhibit the free and frank exchange of information among agency personnel.

FOIA Exemption 6 exempts from disclosure personnel or medical files and similar files the release of which would cause a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy. This requires a balancing of the public's right to disclosure against the individual's right to privacy. The privacy interests of the individuals in the records you have requested outweigh any minimal public interest in disclosure of the information. Any private interest you may have in that information does not factor into the aforementioned balancing test.

FOIA Exemption 7(A) protects from disclosure records or information compiled for law enforcement purposes, the release of which could reasonably be expected to interfere with enforcement proceedings. I have determined that the information you are seeking relates to an ongoing criminal law enforcement investigation. Therefore, I am withholding all records, documents, and/or other material, which if disclosed prior to completion, could reasonably be expected to interfere with law enforcement proceedings and final agency actions related to those proceedings. Please be advised that once all pending matters are resolved and FOIA Exemption 7(A) is no longer applicable, there may be other exemptions which could protect certain information from disclosure, such as FOIA Exemptions (2), 7(C), 7(D), and 7(E).

FOIA Exemption 7(C) protects records or information compiled for law enforcement purposes that could reasonably be expected to constitute an unwarranted invasion of personal privacy. This exemption takes particular note of the strong interests of individuals, whether they are suspects, witnesses, or investigators, in not being unwarrantably associated with alleged criminal activity. That interest extends to persons who are not only the subjects of the investigation, but those who may have their privacy invaded by having their identities and information about them revealed in connection with an investigation. Based upon the traditional recognition of strong privacy interest in law enforcement records, categorical withholding of information that identifies third parties in law enforcement records is ordinarily appropriate. As such, I have determined that the privacy interest in the identities of individuals in the records you have requested clearly outweigh any minimal public interest in disclosure of the information. Please note that any private interest you may have in that information does not factor into this determination.

FOIA Exemption 7(E) protects records compiled for law enforcement purposes, the release of which would disclose techniques and/or procedures for law enforcement investigations or prosecutions or would disclose guidelines for law enforcement investigations or prosecutions if such disclosure could reasonably be expected to risk circumvention of the law.

FOIA Exemption 7(F) permits the government to withhold all information about any individual when disclosure of information about him could reasonably be expected to endanger the life or physical safety of any individual. This exemption also protects physical security at critical infrastructure sites.

While an adequate search was conducted, you have the right to appeal the above withholding determination. Should you wish to do so, you must send your appeal and a copy of this letter, within 90 days of the date of this letter, to: Privacy Office, Attn: FOIA Appeals, U.S. Department of Homeland Security, 2707 Martin Luther King Avenue SE, Mail Stop 0655, Washington, D.C. 20528-0655, following the procedures outlined in the DHS FOIA regulations at 6 C.F.R. Part 5 § 5.8. Your envelope and letter should be marked "FOIA Appeal." Copies of the FOIA and DHS FOIA regulations are available at www.dhs.gov/foia.

Provisions of the FOIA allow DHS to recover part of the cost of complying with your request. In this instance, because the cost is below the \$25.00 minimum, there is no charge.







Background: The IPAG is a joint effort between the Homeland Security and Emergency Management Agency (HSEMA), the Metropolitan Police Department of the District of Columbia (MPD), and the Mayor's Office of Religious Affairs (MORA).
