**AN ACT CONCERNING THE RIGHT TO BE AND PRIVILEGES OF AN
ELECTOR.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 9 of the general statutes be amended to provide that any
- 2 person convicted of sedition, insurrection, rebellion or a felony in
- 3 relation to any such act shall permanently (1) forfeit such person's right
- 4 to be an elector and such person's privileges as an elector, and (2) be
- 5 prohibited from (A) being a candidate for or holding public office in the
- 6 state, and (B) being employed by the state or any political subdivision
- 7 thereof.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide that convicts of certain crimes shall permanently (1) forfeit
their electoral rights and privileges, and (2) be prohibited from
employment by the state or any political subdivision thereof.
