Following a series of court developments in 2023 and this month, former President Donald Trump's 2024 legal schedule has come into focus, as has his political one. In the calendar below, we capture significant events in both domains—and how they interrelate. For those who are checking our calendar frequently, and simply want to know what the most recent updates are since the prior version we published, those updates are listed below. \* Judge Chutkan's [Jan. 18 order](#) stated that, inter alia, "Until the [DC Cir.] mandate is returned in this case, the parties shall not file any substantive pretrial motions without first seeking leave of court, and any such request for leave shall state whether the proposed motion concerns matters involved in the appeal or is instead ancillary to it." This follows Chutkan's [automatic stay](#) last month of any "further proceedings that would move" Trump's "case towards trial or impose additional burdens of litigation on" him, which shall include all "deadlines and proceedings scheduled" in the court's [Aug. 28 pretrial order](#). In response to that stay order, the government [said](#) that "in light of the public's strong interest in a prompt trial," it would "continue to meet all of its deadlines" in the court's pretrial order. Approval by the court will now be required to make such filings.

The deadlines and proceedings that have stayed and require court approval for any filings have been marked in **bold and purple** in the calendar below.

\*\*\* There is currently no public docket for the Oregon or 9th Cir./D. Ariz. 14th Amendment challenges. For the latter, we instead link to the 9th Cir. docket on [PACER](#). Also, given the [public docket](#) for 11th Cir./S.D. Fla. 14A is not up-to-date, we have linked to [PACER](#). In that case, supplemental briefing is complete and we are now awaiting the 11th Cir. decision to Castro's appeal of distr Aileen Cannon's [order](#) refusing to disqualify Trump. <sup>3</sup> On Jan. 4, five state voters, represented by Free Speech for People, [filed an objection](#) with the Illinois State Board of Elections (SEB) to remove Trump from the state ballot. On Jan. 17, during a special board meeting, the case was assigned to a hearing officer. During the coming days, that [officer will conduct a follow-up hearing\(s\) \(on a currently undisclosed date\)](#) with both parties' counsel and a report and recommendation will be sent to the SEB's general counsel. [General counsel will then provide its own recommendation to the SEB's full 8-member board](#) which will then vote on the objection. Five votes are required to remove Trump from the ballot, and a 4-4 tie means Trump can remain on the ballot. The SEB's decision is subject to challenge in the courts and could be heard by the Illinois Supreme Court.
