FINAL JUDGMENT

On this day, the Court considered the above-captioned case. On January 20, 2026, this Court issued a “Memorandum Opinion and Order,” ECF No. 10, granting in part Petitioner Hector Miguel Aguilar Rosado’s “Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus and Complaint for Declaratory and Injunctive Relief,” ECF No. 1, filed on December 11, 2025. Therein, this Court asserted jurisdiction over the instant matter, and found Petitioner established a violation of the Fifth Amendment’s Due Process Clause as applied to him. Accordingly, the Court ordered either Petitioner’s immediate release from custody or reinstatement of the Immigration Judge’s original bond decision, dated August 28, 2025.

On January 27, 2026, the parties filed a “Joint Status,” ECF No. 11, advising Petitioner had been released from custody and there are no more issues before the Court. Because no live issues remain, the Court enters final judgment in accordance with Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 58.

Accordingly, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that District Clerk **SHALL CLOSE** this case.
