IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. Respondents are directed to file an answer to Petitioner Daniel Felipe C. C.'s Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus (ECF No. 1 ("Petition")) on or before Wednesday, February 4, 2026, certifying the true cause and proper duration of Daniel Felipe C. C.'s confinement and showing cause why the writ should not issue in this case;
2. Respondents' answer must include:
 - a. Such affidavits and exhibits as are needed to establish the lawfulness and correct duration of Daniel Felipe C. C.'s detention in light of the issues raised in his Petition;

- b. A reasoned memorandum of law and fact explaining Respondents' legal position on Daniel Felipe C. C.'s claims, including whether this Court has jurisdiction to hear his claims; and
 - c. Respondents' recommendation on whether an evidentiary hearing should be conducted;
3. Daniel Felipe C. C. is directed to file a reply to Respondents' answer on or before Monday, February 9, 2026; and
4. No further submissions from either party will be permitted except as authorized by Court order.
