

1 than 6 months without being afforded a bond hearing violates Petitioner’s constitutional and
2 statutory rights.

3 The Court preliminarily concludes that Petitioner’s petition may be cognizable under 28
4 U.S.C. § 2241. In addition, because Petitioner was incarcerated at Golden State Annex at the time
5 of filing, and that facility lies within the Eastern District of California, this Court has jurisdiction
6 to proceed to the merits of the petition. *Doe v. Garland*, 109 F.4th 1188, 1197-99 (9th Cir. 2024)
7 (holding that the Eastern District of California exercises jurisdiction over core habeas corpus
8 petitions filed by petitioners confined at Golden State Annex), *pet. for rehrng. en banc or panel*
9 *rehrng. den’d*, No. 23-15361 (9th Cir. May 29, 2025).

10 **Conclusion and Order**

11 This Court has conducted a preliminary review of the petition. It is not clear from the face
12 of the petition whether Petitioner is entitled to relief. Accordingly, pursuant to Habeas Rule 4, the
13 Court HEREBY ORDERS:

- 14 1. Respondents SHALL FILE a response addressing the merits or seeking dismissal of
15 the Petition within **60 days** of the date of service of this order. Respondents shall
16 include with the response any and all transcripts or other documents relevant to the
17 resolution of the issues presented in the petition. Habeas Rule 5.
- 18 2. Respondents SHALL FILE a Notice of Appearance within **14 days** of the date of
19 service of this Order.
- 20 3. Petitioner’s TRAVERSE to any Answer or OPPOSITION to any Motion to Dismiss
21 filed by Respondent is due on or before **30 days** from the date Respondents’ filing.
- 22 4. The Clerk of Court is DIRECTED to send an electronic copy of this Order and a
23 copy of the Petition and all exhibits to the Office of the United States Attorney for
24 the Eastern District of California, an agent for the appropriate correctional
25 institution, if applicable, and to mail a copy of this order to Petitioner.
