Respondents argue that Petitioner is subject to mandatory detention under 8 U.S.C. § 1226(c) and that, under the Supreme Courts ruling in <i>Demore</i> , Petitioner does not have a due process right to release or a bond hearing for prolonged detention. The Court disagrees and applies the three factors enumerated in <i>Lopez v. Garland</i> to determine whether Respondents have violated Petitioner's Due Process rights. Because those factors weigh in Petitioner's favor, the Court GRANTS IN PART and DENIES IN PART the petition. Accordingly, the Court GRANTS IN PART the Petition and ORDERS Respondent to provide Petitioner with an individualized bond hearing within fourteen days.
