ORDER GRANTING PETITION AND
ENTRY OF JUDGMENT UNDER
28 U.S.C. § 2241

On January 17, 2026, Petitioner Nona Hasratyan, proceeding through counsel, filed a Verified Petition for Habeas Corpus and Complaint for Injunctive and Declaratory Relief (the “Petition”) concurrently with a Motion for a Temporary Restraining Order. (Dkt. Nos. 1, 2.) On February 2, 2026, the Court granted preliminary relief. (Dkt. No. 10.) On April 29, 2026, the parties filed a Joint Proposed Grant of Petition and Entry of Judgment Under 28 U.S.C. § 2241, jointly proposing the Petition be granted and judgment be entered consistent with the reasons and findings

1 set forth in the Court's Orders on preliminary relief, without requiring further
2 proceedings. (Dkt. No. 21.)

3 In accordance with the parties' Joint Proposed Grant of Petition and Entry of
4 Judgment Under 28 U.S.C. § 2241 (Dkt. No. 21) and for the reasons stated in the Court's
5 Order granting preliminary relief (Dkt. No. 10), the Petition is granted. Judgment is to
6 be entered consistent with this Order.
