CUSTODY ORDER

It is hereby ordered that ICE/ERO will transfer custody of VIVIAN G. SORIANO NETO (“Petitioner”) to the **Rhode Island Division of Sheriffs at Providence County Superior Court, Licht Judicial Complex, 250 Benefit St., Providence, Rhode Island, 02905, for a Pre-Trial Conference at 9:30 a.m.** before the Honorable Judge Cruise in Courtroom 4, on **January 14, 2026**. The Pre-Trial conference is scheduled in relation to pending Superior Court case no. P2-2025-3276(B) in which Petitioner is a named defendant.

While present at Providence County Superior Court, Licht Judicial Complex, 250 Benefit St., Providence, Rhode Island, 02905, for her Pre-Trial Conference before the Honorable Judge Cruise, Petitioner shall remain in the custody of the Rhode Island Division of Sheriffs, whether in the cellblock or while making an in-court appearance associated with her Pre-Trial Conference before the Honorable Judge Cruise.

While in their custody, the Rhode Island Division of Sheriffs shall ensure Petitioner’s continued detention during her Pre-Trial proceedings while in the


Superior Court building, whether in the cellblock or while attending any necessary in-court appearances.

The Superior Court Justice presiding over the Pre-Trial proceedings shall order Petitioner's return to ICE/ERO's custody following completion of the proceedings and will not allow her to be released at any time during or upon completion of the Superior Court proceedings.

The Rhode Island Division of Sheriffs shall return Petitioner to the custody of ICE/ERO immediately after the conclusion of the above-referenced Superior Court proceedings.

If Petitioner's pending state criminal matter Superior Court no. P2-2025-3276(B) is resolved by way of plea or other dispositive action, the Petitioner shall be returned to ICE/ERO immediately after the conclusion of the above-referenced hearing, or if resolution of Petitioner's state criminal case results in a term of incarceration at a Rhode Island correctional facility, prior to Petitioner's release from that state term of incarceration, officials at the state correctional facility and/or the Rhode Island Division of Sheriffs shall notify ICE/ERO of the impending expiration of Petitioner's state term of incarceration and, upon its expiration, immediately return Petitioner directly to the custody of ICE/ERO.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
