**FINAL JUDGMENT**

For the reasons and in the manner set forth in the Court’s prior Memorandum Opinion & Order, (Dkt. No. 13), Petitioner’s Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus, (Dkt. No. 1), was **GRANTED in part and DENIED in part**. The Court ordered Respondents to provide Petitioner a bond hearing or release him. (Dkt. No. 13 at 5). The Court further ordered the parties to file an advisory on the status of the bond hearing or release by January 29, 2026. (*Id.*)


