**ORDER
FOR SHOW CAUSE
HEARING**

Respondents.

Yesterday morning, Respondents were ordered to file a letter by 4:00 p.m. confirming the current location of Petitioner Estefany J.S.'s detention. (Doc. No. 8 at 3.) After the deadline passed with no filing, Respondents were ordered to (1) immediately file the letter and (2) file a written memorandum by noon today explaining the failure to comply with the order and showing cause for why further remedial action, including sanctions, should not be imposed. (*See* Doc. No. 9.)

At 11:51 a.m. today, Respondents filed a letter stating that Petitioner has been transferred to El Paso, Texas, and that they have asked for more details about the transfer. (Doc. No. 11.) Respondents did not file the written show cause response as ordered, and their letter does not respond to the show cause order.

Accordingly, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that:

1. Respondents shall file the written show cause response as ordered **by no later than 5:00 p.m. today.**

2. Alternatively, a show cause hearing is set for **tomorrow, January 15, 2026, at 9:00 a.m.**, in Courtroom 7A (STP). Daniel Rosen and/or Ana Voss must attend the hearing on behalf of Respondents. Justin Page's attendance is optional. Petitioner's counsel may attend but is not required.

3. At the hearing, Respondents' counsel must explain the failure to comply with the Court's order and show cause for why further remedial action, including sanctions, should not be imposed.
