On February 2, 2026, the Court granted Petitioner's petition for writ of habeas corpus and ordered Petitioner's immediate release. (Doc. No. 8.) Respondents were also ordered to file an update on or before February 5, 2026 confirming Petitioner's release. Respondents did not file any such update.

Accordingly, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that:

1. Respondents must file a letter no later than 10 a.m. CT on February 9, 2026, confirming that Petitioner was released, and if not, the reasons for his continued detention, and the schedule for his release.

2. Absent assurance that Petitioner will be released by 11:00 a.m. CT on February 9, 2026, the Court will issue an order to show cause why Respondents should not be held in contempt, and a contempt hearing shall be scheduled.
