Proceedings: HEARING RE: PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION

Counsel state their appearances. The Court confers with counsel and hears oral argument. For the reasons stated on the record, the Court hereby **ORDERS** as follows:

1. Petitioners' application for a preliminary injunction is **DENIED as moot**. Respondents have provided all Petitioners with individualized bond hearings. Although Respondents failed to provide bond hearings for Petitioners Martinez and Pena by the seven-day timeline specified in the Court's Order re Petitioners' *Ex Parte* Application for a TRO [ECF No. 10], the Court concludes that because all Petitioners have now received the requested bond hearings, a preliminary injunction granting the same relief is moot.

2. The Court will issue a separate Order to Show Cause regarding the dismissal of the underlying petition and an Order to Show Cause regarding sanctions for Respondents' failure to comply with the Court's TRO.

3. A hearing on the Orders to Show Cause is **SET** for Friday, February 6, 2026, at 9:00 a.m.
