**ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE**

On February 1, 2026, the Court granted Petitioner's Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus and ordered that she be immediately released. (ECF 6.) As of February 5, 2026, Petitioner's counsel reports that Petitioner still has not been released and instead remains in custody in Crow Wing County Jail. (ECF 7.) Respondents are hereby **ORDERED TO SHOW CAUSE** on or before February 6, 2026, why sanctions should not be imposed for the failure to comply with the Court's Order.

Further, the Court reiterates and **ORDERS** that Petitioner must be immediately released. The severity of any sanction the Court may choose to impose will increase if Petitioner has not been released by 5:00 p.m. today (February 5, 2026).
