Dear Mr. Brown:

I am writing to inform you of a revision to the license requirements imposed in my letter dated June 12, 2026 regarding the Claude Mythos 5 Model and Claude Fable 5 Model (the "Covered Models").

Since the issuance of my June 12 letter, Anthropic has worked with the U.S. government to address risks associated with the Covered Models. These efforts have yielded significant progress. In addition, Anthropic has committed to work with the U.S. government on protocols and standards and releases for the Covered Models.

In light of this progress, as well as the Department of Commerce's ("Commerce") evaluation of the diversion risks currently presented by the Covered Models, I have determined that appropriate safeguards are in place to permit certain trusted partners to access the Claude Mythos 5 Model. Accordingly, a license will no longer be required to export, reexport, or in-country transfer (including deemed exports and reexports) the Claude Mythos 5 Model to entities identified in Annex A to this letter and their foreign national employees, or to Anthropic's foreign national employees. Commerce may amend the list of entities in Annex A at any time. All other requirements of the June 12 letter remain in effect until further notice.

I reserve the right to reevaluate and adjust the scope of license requirements on the Covered Models, should circumstances change.
