Petitioner seeks habeas relief under 28 U.S.C. § 2241. The Court finds that a response is appropriate. Accordingly, it is **ORDERED**:



2. Petitioner is also directed to serve this order on Respondents by 4/28/2026, and file proof of service. Petitioner does not need to obtain a summons to do so.

Under 28 U.S.C. § 2243, Respondents are **DIRECTED** to show cause why Petitioner's Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus (Doc. 1) should not be granted. After careful review of the petition and its attachments, the Court finds good cause to allow Respondents until 5/11/2026, to do so.
