**Proceedings: (IN CHAMBERS) ORDER DENYING MOTION TO ENFORCE  
COURT ORDER WITHOUT PREJUDICE (ECF 6)**

Petitioner is a noncitizen detainee who filed a counseled petition for a writ of habeas corpus under 28 U.S.C. § 2241 on April 6, 2026. (ECF 1). On that same day, Petitioner was transferred from the Adelanto Detention Facility (within this Court’s jurisdiction) to the El Paso Camp East Montana Detention Facility in El Paso, Texas. (ECF 6, 10). As a result, Petitioner filed an emergency motion requesting that the court enforce General Order 26-05’s notice of removal provisions and requiring that Petitioner be promptly returned to Adelanto, California. (ECF 6). In response the next day, Respondents informed the court that Petitioner will be returned to Adelanto on April 13, 2026. (ECF 10 at 2).

Petitioner’s motion to enforce General Order 26-05 is thus DENIED as moot. The denial is without prejudice, however, if she is not returned to Adelanto by April 13 as scheduled. The parties must file a joint status report within 48 hours of petitioner’s return to this district or by no later than April 17, 2026, whichever occurs sooner. Meanwhile, once Petitioner has returned to this district, Respondents are ENJOINED from removing her from the United States or transferring her outside this district pending further order of this Court.
