IT IS FURTHER ORDERED the Motion for Preliminary Injunction (ECF No. <u>2</u>) is DENIED as moot. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED Respondents must provide Petitioner with a constitutionally adequate bond hearing pursuant to 8 U.S.C. § 1226(a) by April 27, 2026. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that if bond is granted, Respondents are ORDERED to IMMEDIATELY RELEASE Petitioner from detention. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Petitioner be afforded until May 27, 2026, to satisfy any monetary bond conditions. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that if a constitutionally adequate bond hearing is not conducted by April 27, 2026, Respondents must IMMEDIATELY RELEASE Petitioner from custody on his own recognizance. This means Respondents are PROHIBITED from imposing release conditions that substantially interfere with Petitioner's liberty, such as electronic monitoring, without having established the reasonableness of those restrictions, by clear and convincing evidence, at a pre-deprivation hearing. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Parties shall file a joint status report by April 28, 2026. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Acting Attorney General of the United State Todd Blanche is SUBSTITUTED for currently named Respondent Pamela Bondi. The Clerk of Court is kindly instructed to update the docket accordingly. The Clerk of Court is further instructed to enter judgment accordingly and close this case. The Court retains jurisdiction to enforce its order and judgment. Petitioner may move to reopen this case to enforce the judgment without filing a separate case. The Court also retains jurisdiction to consider Petitioner's request for fees and costs pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2412. Initially, the Court finds Federal Respondents are in violation of the Court's 11 Order. They failed to join Petitioner in his 14 Status Report and failed to (1) detail the reasons bond was denied and (2) attach the Order of the immigration judge denying Petitioner bond. <u>See</u> ECF No. 11 at 7. Further, it appears Petitioner was transferred outside of this District without notice to Petitioner's counsel, at an unknown date and time, potentially in violation of this Court's Order. <u>See</u> Order to Show Cause, ECF No. 5 at 3. Therefore, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Federal Respondents must file a status report by TODAY, 4/29/2026. The Status Report must ATTACH the Order of the immigration court denying bond and confirm WHEN the contemporaneous record of the bond hearing will be provided to Petitioner and this Court as ordered. <u>See</u> ECF No. 11 at 7. The Status Report must further disclose WHEN Petitioner was transferred from this district and the basis for that transfer and WHERE Petitioner is currently detained. Finally, the Court finds expedited consideration of Petitioner's 13 Motion to Reopen to enforce the Court's judgment is warranted. Federal Respondents must respond by 5/4/2026. Petitioner must reply by 5/7/2026. The Clerk of Court is instructed to reopen this case for the limited purpose of adjudicating the 13 Motion seeking enforcement of this Court's judgment.
