ORDER:

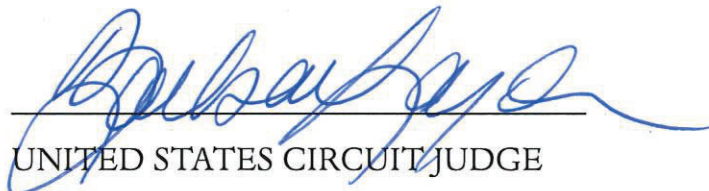
